

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INTRODUCTION

This is a report on the preliminary eligibility and classification determinations resulting from a comprehensive state-wide inventory of potentially eligible rivers for inclusion in the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System. The inventory was conducted by the six Arizona National Forests at the request of the Arizona Congressional delegation.

In order to facilitate the analysis of each stream's potential for designation, an ad hoc task force was organized which consisted of representatives from the Apache-Sitgreaves, Coconino, Coronado, Kaibab, Prescott, and Tonto National Forests, the Southwestern Regional Office, and the Arizona Game & Fish Department. An interdisciplinary approach to the analysis was developed and coordination between Forests was carried out. Each Forest was given the task of conducting the preliminary analysis in a timely manner, based on USDA-USDI guidelines, Forest Service policy, and the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.

Using the agreed-upon approach developed by the task force, each Forest team began the evaluation process for possible designation. The first test was for "Eligibility". To be eligible for inclusion, a stream must be free-flowing and (with its adjacent land area) must possess one or more "outstandingly remarkable" values. The values which were considered are: scenic, recreational, geologic, fish, wildlife, historic, cultural, riparian, and ecological.

If a river segment was judged to be eligible, the second test and analysis was carried out: "Classification". The potential classification of a stream is based on the condition of that stream and the adjacent Federal lands as they exist at this time. The Act specifies three different classification categories that a stream segment may qualify for: Wild, Scenic, or Recreational. Based on established guidelines, each eligible stream segment was analyzed using the impoundment test, the accessibility test, the primitiveness test, the development test, and the water pollution test. This resulted in each stream segment being given a specific classification rating, or being rejected (if one or more of the classification tests was failed).

The final test for possible designation is "Suitability". In many cases, this critical part of the overall analysis has not yet been accomplished. Refer to each individual river sheet to determine the status of the suitability test.


The report is organized by river basins. Each section contains information on river segments determined to be eligible by the Forest Service. They also include information on segments proposed by the Arizona Rivers Coalition but determined not eligible. The last section contains a listing of all potentially eligible segments which were evaluated and found ineligible.

The Table of Contents includes a two-letter code for the National Forests which administer the river segments. The codes are:




RIVER BASIN MAP


